### **METHOD OF PAYMENT**

Payment for goods and services is expected at time of arrangements and required prior to the services rendered. For your convenience, we accept cash, check, credit card (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express).

The goods and services shown below are those we provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must purchase any item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

“Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent’s survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, or by on behalf of the decedent.”

**Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead: \$1350.00**

This is the basic charge to each family which we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also, included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filing of necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral, and placement of obituary notices. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial and forwarding and receiving remains.)

**Embalming: \$695.00**

(Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law.) Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by this state must complete this procedure. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you so not want embalming, you usually have a right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

This charge includes transfer from local airport to our care center, basic services of Funeral Director and Staff, sheltering of remains, re-issue permit and local transportation of remains to local cemetery. This charge does not include visitation or ceremonies.

**Immediate Burial:** **From** **\$1505.00 to \$10,500.00**

Our charges for immediate burial (without any rites or ceremonies at the funeral home, graveside or elsewhere) include the removal or remains, transportation to the cemetery, refrigeration of remains and basic services of staff.

Immediate Burial with casket provided by the purchaser: **\$1505.00**

Immediate Burial with minimum casket from our facility: **\$1900.00**

**Direct Cremation:** **From** **\$1445.00 - \$10,440.00**

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering).

Our charge for Direct Cremation, without ceremony includes removal of remains, transportation to crematory, refrigeration, basic services of staff, crematory fee, and plastic urn. (This is a non scheduled 8 – 10 day time frame).

Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser: **\$1445.00**

Direct cremation with cardboard container, alternative container heavy cardboard: **\$1505.00**

Additional Charge for Rush Cremation ( 2 – 3 day process after acquiring permit) **\$ 200.00**

Additional Charge for Witness Cremation: **\$ 200.00**

Additional Charge for cases in excess of 300 Lbs.: **\$ 200.00**
